### INGREDIENT STATEMENT

45% Soybean Hulls, Processed Grain by-Products, Alfalfa, Beet Pulp, Corn, Molasses Products, Yeast Culture, Salt, Soybean Meal, Calcium Carbonate, Modified Starch, Monocalcium Phosphate, Magnesium Oxide, Ferrous Sulfate, Choline Chloride, Vitamin E Supplement, Ethoxyquin and BHA (as preservatives), Copper Sulfate, Niacin, d-Calcium Pantothenate, Vitamin A Supplement, Biotin, Thiamine Mononitrate, Riboflavin, Pyridoxine Hydrochloride, Vitamin B-12 Supplement, Folic Acid, Menadione Sodium Bisulfite Complex, L-Lysine, Dried *Saccharomyces cerevisiae* fermentation solubles, Hydrated Sodium Calcium Aluminosilicate, Silicon Dioxide, Zinc Proteinate, Manganese Proteinate, Copper Proteinate, Cobalt Proteinate, Selenium Yeast, Brewer's Dried Yeast, Yucca Extract, Natural and Artificial Flavors, *Saccharomyces cerevisiae*, Dried *Enterococcus faecium* fermentation product, Dried *Lactobacillus acidophilus* fermentation product, Dried *Aspergillus oryzae* fermentation extract, Potassium Sulfate, Magnesium Sulfate, Sulfur, Zinc Sulfate, Manganese Sulfate, Sodium Selenite, Cobalt Sulfate, Ethylenediamine Dihydride, Vitamin D<sub>3</sub> Supplement, Ascorbic Acid, Dextrose, Sodium aluminosilicate, Beta Glucan (encapsulating agent), Vegetable Oil.

### FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Do not feed or water extremely hot, tired animals. Feed at the rate of 1.5-2.2 lb. of feed per 100 lbs. of body weight (15-22 pounds per head per day for a 1000 pound horse) for Senior horses depending on activity and current body condition. Split feedings into at least two feedings per day. Feeding levels over 20 pounds per head per day should be done in three split feedings. **DO NOT FEED OVER 10 POUNDS PER 1000 POUNDS OF BODY WEIGHT IN ANY ONE FEEDING.** Keep fresh water available at all times. Good quality hay or green growing pasture may be used to supplement this feed if desired.

**WARNING:** Do not feed to sheep; contains supplemental copper.
